

Maths



In Maths this half-term, the children will be studying money and multiplication. They will be recognising the coins, make totals using different combinations of coins and use subtraction to help them find change. Multiplication- the children will divide amounts into equal groups. They will use arrays to help solve problems. They will use the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's Maths: Check understanding of 'X' and '=' symbol. Look at value of coins and notes at home.
