In English this half-term, the children will be writing their own adventure narratives, incorporating a natural disaster they have learned about. They will be building on year 3 writing skills such as using expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials, and direct speech.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English: Ask your child about ambitious vocabulary at school and their word choice.
