

## English



In English this half-term, the children will be writing persuasive leaflets. We will focus on precise adjectives, subordinate clauses (conjunctions), exaggerations, facts and opinions. By the end of the half term, the children will have created their own 'land' and written a leaflet persuading people to visit.

**Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English:** Ask your child about grammar at school and how they would use this. Collect and read leaflets. They are free in many shops!
