

English



In English this half-term, the children will be completing a book study of *The Explorer* by Katherine Rundell. We will be reading the book both in Guided Reading and English lessons and completing varied tasks relating to the text.

Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English:

Review elements of grammar, such as subordinating and coordinating conjunctions, fronted adverbials, relative clauses, word classes and modal verbs.

Science



This half-term, we will be studying Space. The children will learn about the movement of the moon, the sun and other planets. In addition, they will use Earth rotation to explain day and night due to the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.
