

## English



In English this half-term, the children will begin by writing a monologue as a character from the Greatest Showman. They will then write from opposing viewpoints, one formal and one informal, discussing whether or not the circus should continue to exist. Finally, they will write a formal letter to the bank, requesting funding for Barnam's extravaganza!

**Suggestions of ways you can support your child's English:** Encourage your child to read at least 4 times per week. This must be with a leveled library book in order to collect merits for reading. Talk to the children about what they have read and question their understanding.
