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What is SEND? A pupil has Special Educational Needs and/or a Disability (SEND) if they have a learning difficulty or disability which calls for special educational provision to be made for them.



Message from Mrs Thomas (SENDCO)

I want to say a huge welcome to all our new pupils and families. It has been a busy start to the school year and the children have settled well into their new classes.

Last Term, I carried out a parent survey and it was great to hear how you feel we are doing. Nearly all parents who responded said their children were happy in school, and that you would recommend us to another parent. Thank you for sending in your views. It is really appreciated.

What has been happening to improve SEND provision in school?

We have changed the way we share information with you about your child's needs and their additional provision in school. You will have received a copy of your child's new Individual Support Plan (ISP) plan with this newsletter. We are hoping that it gives you more information about the additional provision provided for your child and how you can help them at home. During our second INSET day at the start of the term, we spent the whole day talking about SEND provision. We have increased the amount of support that is available to all children in the school. This means we can respond quicker to any gaps in learning that arise. This may mean that less children need to go on to our SEN register and that some children may be removed from it this term. I will always write to you to explain any decisions that are made about your child being on the SEN register.
